Pray: Light a candle and open your devotion time with a prayer.

God of the Covenant, let us never forget that you are our God, and that you call us into loving relationship with you and with one another. Inspire us by your word to follow in your way. In the name of Jesus we pray. Amen.



Read: Read the key verse from Sunday's reading.

The king stood by the pillar and made a covenant before the Lord, to follow the Lord, keeping his commandments, his decrees, and his statutes, with all his heart and all his soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. All the people joined in the covenant. 2 Kings 23:3



Reflect: Reflect on the scripture summary.

At multiple points and in many different ways after assuming the throne, King Josiah attempts to "turn the ship"—to redeem past wrongs committed by God's people and to call them back into right relationship with the divine and with each other.
